Bengaluru: In a tragic incident reported from Karnataka capital Bengaluru, a security guard lost his life after he was electrocuted in a flooded basement. The incident took place at an apartment on Lavelle Road on Monday when deceased was trying to start a generator in the basement.

The victim has been identified as Pepu Kumar Sahu. He worked as a security guard in Hulkul Ascent apartment on Levelle Road. The man died at the basement of the Hulkul building, according to an FIR filed at Cubbon Park police station.
